Online Resources for Researching British Ancestry

More British documents are being digitized and made available online each year. In this presentation, participants will be introduced to the online resources that are most useful in tracing British ancestors. Both free and subscription sites will be discussed. England, Scotland, Wales, and Northern Ireland will all be covered. All major categories of genealogical research will be featured including civil records, church records, census data, newspaper archives, as well as other sources unique to Britain.

The presentation will be approximately 45 minutes and an additional 15 minutes will be left for questions & answers.
